Resolution No. C-87-183


- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc. (USET, Inc.) is an inter-tribal council whose membership is comprised of sixteen federally recognized American Indian tribes throughout the eastern United States; and
- WHEREAS, the USET, Inc. is concerned about the health and welfare of the American Indian people in the USET Area and the U.S.; and
- WHEREAS, the USET, Inc. desires to improve the health status of American Indians and raise their health status to the highest possible level; and
- WHEREAS, the USET, Inc. has had a representative on the National Indian Health Board (NIHB) since the inception of USET, Inc.; and
- WHEREAS, the National Indian Health Board has the goal of improving the health care and the health status of American Indians and Alaska Natives; and
- WHEREAS, the USET, Inc. recognizes the NIHB as the entity to advocate for the betterment of health and address national health issues concerning Native Americans and Alaska Natives.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET, Inc. fully supports the National Indian Health Board, will continue to have representation on the NIHB, and will continue to work closely with the NIHB towards fulfillment of common goals in the field of health.

CERTIFICATION


This resolution will remain in effect until rescinded. Any change in the USET representation to the NIHB will be communicated via written correspondence.

This resolution was duly passed at the Executive Committee Meeting of the Board of Directors, at which a quorum was present, in Atmore, Alabama; April 2, 1987.
