Resolution No. B-88-198


WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes is an inter-tribal Council composed of seventeen federally recognized tribes in the Eastern United States; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the U.S.E.T., INC., BOARD supports the efforts of the St. Regis Mohawk's motion to acquire adequate funding for the development of law enforcement and judicial programs and services for their reservation community, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the U.S.E.T. INC., BOARD supports the inclusion of such law enforcement and judicial program funds in the appropriations legislation being considered by the U.S. Congress and the enactment of this legislation by Congress.
