- WHEREAS, P.L. 99-457 mandates the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) to provide services to handicapped children ages 3-5 and 0-3, and
- WHEREAS, the public law mandated the Bureau to effectively coordinate these services to handicapped pre-school children with IHS and other agencies, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau has been reluctant to fund the programs serving sites which do not have BIA-funded schools, and
- WHEREAS, these services to handicapped pre-school children on reservations are not provided by the states.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the USET Board insist that the Bureau immediately establish the coordination of the services with the IHS and other agencies, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the USET Board insist that the Bureau immediately release funds to the programs serving handicapped pre-school children in order to begin implementation of services.
