SUPPORT OF NIHB PROPOSAL TO CONDUCT NATIONAL CONFERENCE  
AND PRODUCE NEWSLETTER

WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of 18 federally-recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, USET is firmly committed to the goal of advancing the health care status of Indian people to the highest level possible; and

WHEREAS, USET has been and continues to be a member in good standing of the National Indian Health Board (NIHB), an organization representing, on a regional basis, the health care and health policy needs of American Indians and Alaska Natives; and

WHEREAS, NIHB has responded to an Indian Health Service request for proposals to provide national services for Indian people, specifically the coordination of regional and a national conference and publication/dissemination of a health newsletter; and


WHEREAS, NIHB has requested letters and/or resolutions of support for its proposal from the NIHB members,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board officially supports the NIHB proposal to the Indian Health Service for the purposes stated above; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the USET Executive Director be directed to prepare such a letter for signature by the President and to send said letter with a copy of this Resolution to NIHB with all deliberate speed.
