- whereas, it is the responsibility of this USET Area Representative to perform all the duties and tasks associated with his/her position, including reporting to the USET Board; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Board has established a USET Health Directors Committee to review and make recommendations on matters of health care delivery and policy,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Chairperson of the USET Health Directors Committee be appointed as the USET Area Representative to NIHB.
