- whereas, the Congress has not agreed on set-aside funds for Indian Tribes in the Child Development and Education Act of 1989; and
- WHEREAS, Indian Tribes have unique needs with regards to the education and care of their children; and
- whereas, these set-aside funds for Indian Tribes are urgently needed in order for the tribes to operate pre-school programs; and
- WHEREAS, without funds being specifically set aside for Indian Tribes, funds will not be available to operate the programs on Indian reservations,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT USET expeditiously petition Congress to provide set-aside funds for Indian tribes in the Child Development and Education Act of 1989; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT USET contact Eastern Area tribes and request their support to this resolution by lobbying their Congressional representatives for pre-school set-aside funds for Indian children.
