PETITION TO BIA TO PROVIDE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDS TO IMPLEMENTATION OF THE INCREASED COMPENSATION SCHEDULE TO ALL BIA FUNDED SCHOOLS FOR FY 1990 AND THEREAFTER

- whereas, the Bureau of Indian Affairs was mandated by Congress, under P.L. 100-297, Title V, Section 5114 to establish, for contracts for the 1991-92 academic year, and thereafter, the rates of basic compensation, or annual salary rates, for the positions of teachers and counselors (including dormitory counselors and homeliving counselors); and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has adopted the Department of Defense compensation schedule for educators; and
- whereas, that compensation schedule substantially increases the pay rates for teachers and counselors; and
- whereas, implementation of this new compensation schedule will require supplemental funding as current ISEP funding does not provide adequate funds; and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has indicated that supplemental funds would be provided for only BIA-operated schools; and
- whereas, all Bureau of Indian Affairs funded schools are affected by instability of professional staff when they are unable to provide comparable salaries to teachers and counselors due to inadequate funding,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board expeditiously endorse and petition the Bureau of Indian Affairs to provide supplemental funds for implementation of the increased compensation schedule to all BIA funded schools; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT USET request the BIA to increase appropriation requests for FY 90 and thereafter in order to accomodate this request.
