- whereas, the Education Committee has determined the increased financial assistance demand by Native American students along with an increased number of Native students attending post-secondary institutions; and
- WHEREAS, increased post-secondary tuition and costs have been met decreased funding at current levels for Native American students in higher education,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board mandate the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) provide increased funding to Native American tribes for post-secondary education purposes.
