REQUEST TO BIA TO PROVIDE INCREASED FUNDING TO NATIVE  
AMERICAN TRIBES FOR POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION

WHEREAS, the USET Board has established the Education Committee to provide the Board with information on and recommendations regarding the critical educational concerns facing the USET tribes; and

WHEREAS, the Education Committee has reviewed the need for increased funding for Native American post-secondary education in all USET tribes; and


WHEREAS, the Education Committee has determined the increased financial assistance demand by Native American students along with an increased number of Native students attending post-secondary institutions; and


WHEREAS, increased post-secondary tuition and costs have been met decreased funding at current levels for Native American students in higher education,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board mandate the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) provide increased funding to Native American tribes for post-secondary education purposes.
