	passing of Legislation which does not reflect the needs of
	Indian people,

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board formally contact the Secretaries of Education and Interior to ensure the timely dissemination of information pertinent to Indian education issues; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Bureau of Indian Affairs-Office of Indian Education Programs and the U.S. Department of Education-Office of Indian Education be urged to provide at least one month's notice of conferences, public hearings and other meetings to all Tribal Leaders.
