


REQUEST HUD TO RECONSIDER THE RESIDENT MANAGEMENT
INITIATIVE FOR INDIAN HOUSING AUTHORITIES

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of 18 federally-recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, HUD has introduced the new Program Resident Management Initiative; and
- WHEREAS, the program seems to be effective in cities and big authorities; and
- WHEREAS, the Housing Committee feels that this initiative would be detrimental to the existing Indian Housing Authorities and tribal relationships already in place; and
- WHEREAS, this would create a third autonomy which may cause conflict,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT USET support this resolution to instruct HUD to reconsider the Resident Management Initiative for Indian Housing Authorities.
