WHEREAS,	the National Advisory Council on Indian Education has not
	been included in any area of the Indian Nations at Risk
	study, and the aforementioned action implied that the
	direction of the study from its onset was to exclude Indian
	input.

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board contact the Secretary of Education to express our concern that Indian educators must be involved in the Indian Nations at Risk study from beginning to end, and that Indian educators should have been notified of the Coordinator position announcement; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the USET Board support the NACIE Board and Executive Director in ensuring continued Indian Educator's input and involvement in this study.
