CHILD WELFARE TASK FORCE COMMITTEE TO RECOMMEND CHANGES AND REVISIONS OF INDIAN CHILD WELFARE ACT (ICWA) TITLE I AND TITLE II (REGULATIONS) GRANT PROCESS

- the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an WHEREAS. inter-tribal organization comprised of eighteen federally-recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and
- it is a goal of the USET leadership to promote and protect their WHEREAS. Indian families and children by providing services that reflect the unique value of each Indian culture; and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Eastern Area Office (BIA/EAO) has formed a Task Force to study the current services provided to our Indian Families and children under the Indian Child Welfare Program, according to the Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA) (P.L. 95-608); and
- WHEREAS. this Task Force has prepared and presented its preliminary findings to the USET Board for their review and consideration.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board of Directors endorses and supports its concept, the work and recommendations of the Eastern Area Indian Child Welare Task Force, and its report; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the USET Board of Directors call for and endorse the revisions to be made to the Task Force Report, based upon the comments and concerns presented during the USET Board Meeting Indian Child Welfare Task Force presentation held in Mystic, Connecticut, on May 8, 1990.
