AVAILABILITY OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE MONIES THROUGH
THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (DHUD)

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of eighteen (18) federally-recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS, USET, Inc. has established a Housing Committee comprising of representatives from their member Tribal Housing Authorities; and
- WHEREAS, each Housing Authority is mandated to research, develop and write a number of policies that include, but not be limited to, procedures for admissions, grievance procedures, collections, maintenance, drugs, personnel, disbursement and procurement, and capitalization; and
- WHEREAS, these policies and procedures are required in order to comply with applicable federal regulations; and
- WHEREAS, this is a very tedious and time consuming process.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT standard policies and procedures be developed for use by any Housing Authority; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT USET, Inc. pursue Technical Assistance monies through the Department of Housing and Urban Development (DHUD) in order to accomplish this enormous task.
