WHEREAS,	the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal
	organization comprised of twenty (20) federally recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member Tribe's leadership; and

WHEREAS, the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) is in the process of developing a National Indian Policy; and

WHEREAS, the USFWS National Indian Policy defines the relationship between the USFWS and the Tribes and serves as a mission statement for the USFWS to follow with the Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the USFWS is dedicated through the implementation of its National Indian Policy to provide technical assistance to the Tribes in the area of Fish and Wildlife Management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors does hereby support and encourage the USFWS to develop and implement a viable National Indian Policy satisfactory for the needs of the Tribes.
