**RE-ESTABLISH USFWS TECHNICAL
ASSISTANCE OFFICE IN CHEROKEE, N.C.**

WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of twenty (20) federally recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member Tribe's leadership; and


WHEREAS, the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) previously had a Fisheries Office in Cherokee N.C.; and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians are in the process of developing and implementing a Wildlife Management Plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors does hereby request the USFWS to re-establish a Technical Assistance Office in Cherokee, N.C. for the use and benefit of USET Member Tribes in that region.
