
OPPOSITION TO HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES BILL 4141

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of twenty (20) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the House of Representatives Bill 4141 will restrict and impose too many regulations upon the Indian Tribes to procure surplus equipment.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the USET Board of Directors oppose the passage of House of Representatives Bill 4141 and recommend that the Public Law 100-472 be kept in place as it stands.
