WHEREAS,	there is no trial representation from tribes in IHS' Nashville Area
	on the RWAG;

Now, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board does hereby request tribal representation from the Nashville Area on the Indian Health Service's Resource Allocation Work Group.
