
REQUESTING REPRESENTATION ON THE
RESOURCE ALLOCATION WORK GROUP

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc. (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of twenty (20) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member Tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service (IHS) has established a Resource Allocation Work Group (RWAG), which has been working for two (2) years on IHS' funding methodology; and
- WHEREAS, the RWAG is attempting to establish an IHS-wide "simplified" methodology to be implemented for fiscal year 1994; and
- WHEREAS, there is no tribal representation from tribes in IHS' Nashville Area on the RWAG;


Now, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board does hereby request tribal representation from the Nashville Area on the Indian Health Service's Resource Allocation Work Group.
