
RESOLUTION NO. 93-04NC

OPPOSITION TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN
INDIAN EDUCATION GOALS PANEL - HR 92


- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc. (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of twenty (20) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member Tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS, HR 92 introduced by Mr. Kildee proposed the establishment of an Education Goals Panel; and
- WHEREAS, the National Advisory Council on Indian Education (NACIE) serves as a governmental advisory on Indian education issues; and
- WHEREAS, the panel to be created will not reflect either NACIE or the interests of the Indian people. This panel is to expend \$2,000,000 (two million dollars) in mostly redundant and unnecessary activities;
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the USET Board opposes the establishment of an Indian Education Goals Panel as contained in HR 92.
