Resolution No. 94-18-DC

TRIBAL INVOLVEMENT FOR RESOLUTION TRUST CORPORATION

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of twenty-one (21) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS, there exists a need in Indian country to eliminate economic poverty, unemployment and poor living conditions for our Tribal membership; and
- WHEREAS, activities need to be continuously, vigorously explored toward increased improvement of Native economic, employment and housing conditions and opportunities for our Tribal people; and
- WHEREAS, in 1991 Congress passed "The Resolution Trust Corporation, Refinancing, Restructuring and Improvement Act," creating the "Resolution Trust Corporation" (RTC) provides for negotiating directly with public agencies and non-profits for the disposal of housing, land, equipment, banks, etc. acquired by the Federal Government; and
- WHEREAS, RTC has designed programs for the public to acquire the Federal Government surplus and provides access to other RTC programs that will generate improved economic development, financing and joint venture business and subcontracting opportunities for interested persons; and
- WHEREAS, RTC was directed to establish special initiatives to target, promote and ensure minority participation.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that RTC be requested to take immediate action in actively informing, including and recruiting American Indian participation with RTC and provide an immediate formal and detailed relationship with Native Americans throughout Indian country.
