ESTABLISHMENT OF CERTIFICATION BOARD FOR USET AREA ALCOHOL AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNSELORS

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of 21 federally-recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, USET is firmly committed to the goal of advancing the health care status of Indian people to the highest level possible; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Board has established the USET Health Directors Committee for the purpose of reviewing issues of concern and policy regarding health care programs for and/or affecting USET member tribes, and to provide the Board with proposed recommendations and resolutions for the Board's consideration; and
- WHEREAS, following the direction of the USET Board of Directors resolution number B-89-234, the Nashville Area Substance Abuse Certification Board is the product of this effort; and
- WHEREAS, in conjunction with the International Certification Reciprocity Consortium (ICRC) sanctioned by Indian Health Services; and
- whereas, the International Certification Reciprocity Consortium (ICRC) has established standards for member certification boards as a baseline for the Certification of Substance Abuse (Counselor, Associate, Specialist, etc.) credentialing and for granting reciprocity; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Health Directors endorse the Nashville Area Substance Abuse Certification Board activities, and hereby requests the continued support and endorsement of the USET Board; and
- WHEREAS, the participation in the Certification process established by this Board is entirely optional to each Tribal Program.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the USET Board continues to endorse the efforts of the Nashville Area Substance Abuse Certification Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Nashville Area Substance Abuse Certification Board replaces the Nashville Area Certification Committee as referenced in Resolution B-29-234.
