- WHEREAS, the actions taken by USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from member tribes' leader-ship; and
- WHEREAS, the Committee desires to illustrate its commitment to both criminal and civil tribal justice issues, to reflect the participation of tribal law enforcement and tribal justice systems, and to become a more inclusive and effective committee of USET;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

the Criminal Justice Committee recommends that the Board of Directors of USET rename said Committee the "*Tribal Justice Committee*":
