RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF EVELYN ROANHORSE

- WHEREAS, Evelyn Roanhorse is a member of the Navajo Indian Nation and has a Masters Degree in Social Work; and
- WHEREAS, she leaves her position with the Bureau of Indian Affairs Eastern Area Office where she has performed the functions of Social Worker since 1988; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Board of Directors duly recognizes her dedication, commitment and service to the Tribes and staff in the Eastern Area in developing, funding and serving their respective children, families and communities.
