SUPPORT OF THE EXPANSION HEAD START PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET, Inc. Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Education Committee recognizes the need for Head Start programs for Indian children, and
- WHEREAS, there are American Indian children that are not receiving the appropriate preparation for education due to their socio-economic conditions, and
- WHEREAS, the Expansion Head Start Program will significantly enhance the opportunities of success for our Indian children, and
- WHEREAS, the Expansion Head Start Program will service children ages birth to five years old through a partnership with Tribal Child Care Services; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, that the USET Board of Directors supports the Expansion Head Start Program.
