Resolution No. USET 98:23

PUBLICATION OF NAHASDA FINAL RULE

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribe's leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the passage of the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) recognizes the special relationship between Indian tribes and the federal government; and
- WHEREAS, Congress wrote language in the Act that regulations would be developed using the Negotiated Rulemaking Process; and
- WHEREAS, at the conclusion of the Negotiated Rulemaking Process, a final rule was submitted to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for clearance; and
- WHEREAS, Indian housing plans required to access NAHASDA Block Grant funding cannot be realized until a final regulation is published; and
- WHEREAS, without these funds, tribal housing programs in the USET organization will be severely deprived of housing services that would otherwise be initiated under NAHASDA; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors hereby directs the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development to expedite the clearing process and publish the final rule.
