Resolution No. USET 99:20

CONTRACT SUPPORT COSTS DATA RECONCILIATION

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the 106th Congress will be addressing concerns regarding the inequity in the distribution of Contract Support Costs within the Indian Health Service (IHS); and
- WHEREAS, the IHS is currently considering different national distribution methodologies; and
- WHEREAS, a final decision regarding the distribution of Contract Support Costs will be made by the Director of IHS, Dr. Michael Trujillo in the near future; and
- WHEREAS, the IHS NCAI National Policy Workgroup on Contract Support Costs report dated 1/28/99, shows the USET area as one the highest funded areas; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Health Committee has conducted a preliminary review of the data contained in the 1/28/99 report and has found potential errors; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors requests a review and validation of USET specific data.
