Resolution No. USET 99:21

RECOMMENDATION TO DHHS SECRETARY REGARDING VACANCY WITHIN THE OFFICE OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the Office of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS)
 Intergovernmental Affairs Liaison position is currently vacant and has been posted; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Board of Directors acknowledges the importance of having an American Indian Alaskan Native (AI/AN) as the liaison; and
- WHEREAS, the role of the Intergovernmental Affairs Liaison is to communicate concerns from Indian country to the Secretary of DHHS; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors urges priority be given to a qualified AI/AN candidate; and finally be it
- **RESOLVED** if no qualified AI/AN applicants are identified in the first panel of applicants, the position be reposted.
