SUPPORT FOR PLACING DRUG ELIMINATION GRANT MONIES IN INDIAN HOUSING PLAN

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development has suggested that the Drug Elimination Grant funds be formula driven; and
- WHEREAS, Indian tribes and Tribally Designated Housing Entities have not received their fair share of the grant funds through the previous competitive grant distribution; and
- **WHEREAS,** there is a known need for drug elimination funding in Indian Country; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors recommends all requests for Drug Elimination funds be made through the Indian Housing Plan in a new section that shall be developed in consultation with Indian tribes.
