Resolution No. USET 99:33

THE NEW MARKET INITIATIVE CONFERENCE SHOULD NOT BE CONSIDERED TRIBAL CONSULTATION

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- **WHEREAS,** the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has announced a New Market Initiative Conference in early July of 1999; and
- WHEREAS, HUD has announced that this will be tribal consultation; and
- WHEREAS, HUD informed the USET tribes of this conference at the USET Semi-Annual Board Meeting in Miami June 15, 1999; and
- WHEREAS, the late notice does not allow sufficient time for the tribes to prepare for the conference; and
- WHEREAS, HUD has informed the tribes there will be few if any accommodations available in Rapid City during this conference; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors concludes that the New Market Initiative Conference to be held in Rapid City from July 6 to 9, 1999 should not be considered Tribal Consultation as defined in the Executive Order of May 1998 because many tribes throughout the country have not been given proper notification.
