Resolution No. USET 99:44

ENDORSEMENT OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS DIRECTING "CONSULTATION AND COORDINATION WITH INDIAN TRIBAL GOVERNMENTS"

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, President William Jefferson Clinton in 1994 and 1998 promulgated Executive Orders requiring "Consultation and Coordination with Indian Tribal Governments"; and
- WHEREAS, USET, through its delegates, commends the principles expressed in the Executive Orders; and
- WHEREAS, USET member tribes are concerned about the continuance of the intent of the Executive Orders in the next millennium; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors strongly endorses the existing Executive Orders and expresses the need for the Executive Orders to continue, expand, and gain strength through future enforcement; be it further
- **RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors extends its appreciation and gratitude on the part of all American Indian/Alaska Native (AI/AN) people, including the "seven generations," for President Clinton's support of the Government-to-Government relationship by and between AI/AN Nations and the United States of America and underlying treaties.
