Resolution No. USET 99:49

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the Native American Housing and Self Determination Act of 1996 implementing regulation, 24 CFR parts 50 and 58, requires an Environmental Review and allows tribes to choose whether to assume the responsibility themselves or give the responsibility to the Office of Native American Programs (ONAP) within the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and
- WHEREAS, HUD has agreed to accept the responsibility of completing the Environmental Reviews if the tribes designate HUD as the responsible party; and
- WHEREAS, HUD receives funding for training of its staff in completing Environmental Reviews to comply with 24 CFR parts 50 and 58; and
- WHEREAS, HUD has designated an Environmental Officer in each of its area ONAP offices; and
- WHEREAS, HUD has told tribes although they will accept responsibility, they cannot guarantee when the Environmental Reviews will be completed; and
- WHEREAS, without completed Environmental Reviews, Tribes and Tribally Designated Housing Entities are not able to comply with their Indian Housing Plan much less provide members with adequate safe, decent, and sanitary housing so desperately needed in Indian Country; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors respectfully requests that HUD expedite the completion of the Environmental Reviews for which they are responsible.
