GUIDELINES FOR INTERNET COMMERCE (ECOMMERCE)

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the next millennium will usher in new and more efficient means of conducting business and trade in cyberspace under the umbrella of ECOMMERCE; and
- WHEREAS, the new medium of the Internet offers many opportunities for inappropriate and abusive means of conducting Ecommerce; and
- WHEREAS, these inappropriate Ecommerce business practices could have a negative impact on our Youth, Nations, and or Tribal Sovereignty; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors support the development of **Ecommerce** guidelines and recommendations for the appropriate use of the Internet and future cyberspace technologies.
