## SUPPORT OF ALTERNATIVE FUNDING RESOURCES FOR USET SCHOLARSHIP FUND

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Education Committee, through the USET Board of Directors, is charged with advising member tribal governments on Federal Indian Education Programs; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Education Committee was established to promote and develop direction in Indian Education; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Scholarship Fund was instituted to assist member tribal students in their higher education endeavors; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Scholarship Fund does not currently meet the unmet needs of the member tribal students; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors instructs the USET Executive Director to investigate and acquire alternative funding resources to increase the USET Scholarship Fund.
