USET Resolution No. 2000:53

Support of establishing a State Agency, Office or Liaison of Indian Education

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-three (23) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, there is a need for the collection and dissemination of educational information to and from Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, there are some states that do not have a designated Agency, Office or Liaison for this purpose; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors requests that each home state of the USET member Tribes be required to establish an Agency, Office or Liaison of Indian Education to provide these services.
