USET Resolution No. 2000:82

RECOGNITION OF JIM THORPE

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the value of athletic heroes as role models for future generations is well recognized and acknowledged around the world; and
- WHEREAS, American Indian athletes have been largely ignored in national advertising campaigns; and
- WHEREAS, Jim Thorpe or Wa Tha Huck (Bright Path), a Sac and Fox Indian, was the only American athlete in history to excel in three major sports, both as an amateur and a professional; and
- WHEREAS, Jim Thorpe distinguished himself and all American Indian athletes, by his successes at the 1912 Olympics, by his position as first president of the National Football League; his numerous other successes, and his recognition as American's Greatest All-Around Athlete and Greatest Football Player of the Half-Century by an Associated press poll; and
- **WHEREAS**, the use of athletic heroes' images in the advertising campaigns of Wheaties Cereal has provided a national forum for the recognition of such role models; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors hereby supports and encourages the use of Jim Thorpe's image and athletic history in the Wheaties Cereal advertising campaign.
