NATIONAL GUARD BUREAU CROSS-CULTURAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT TRAINING CONFERENCE


- WHEREAS**, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS**, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS**, the National Guard Bureau, in cooperation with the Louisiana Army National Guard and the Native American Historical Initiative have recently sponsored the first Cross-Cultural Resource Management training conference for National Guard agencies and Indian Tribes; and
- WHEREAS**, this conference focused on the preparation of acceptable Integrated Cultural Resource Management Plans for all National Guard installations; and
- WHEREAS**, National Guards of twenty-two states, as well as twelve federally recognized Tribes, were represented; and
- WHEREAS**, the success of this prototype conference was amply demonstrated by the list of attendees, as well as copies of both the spoken and written evaluations which have been provided to the USET Board and the National Guard Bureau; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors hereby encourages the National Guard Bureau to promulgate further conferences based on this cross-cultural model in other regions of the United States and U. S. Territories.
