USET Resolution No. 2001: 034

DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE LANGUAGE PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Defense (DOD) Supply and Language Programs, currently are creating a mechanical system of language translation and instruction; and
- WHEREAS, this agency is seeking the cooperation of USET member Tribes in testing this program among their Tribal citizens, in practical settings; and
- WHEREAS, this program has the ability to support the efforts of the Tribes to preserve their languages; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that USET appreciates the DOD offer and encourages any member tribe desirous of participating to pursue this opportunity.
