USET Resolution No. 2001:07

## ADVISORY COUNCIL PROPOSED SUSPENSION OF SECTION 106 REGULATIONS

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, The Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) has proposed to suspend its Section 106 Regulations; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed suspension will undermine severely the continuing efforts of USET Tribes and, indeed, all Federally recognized Tribes, to regularize the enforcement of the National Historic Preservation Act; and
- WHEREAS, without clear guidance, the potential exists for avoidance of compliance with the Section 106 Regulations; and
- WHEREAS, the original premise for the suspension has been obviated by the corrective actions currently being taken by the ACHP; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors calls upon the ACHP not to go forward with the suspension but, rather, to vote on a final re-adoption of the current Regulations at the forthcoming (Nov. 16<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup>) meeting.
