USET Resolution No. 2000:09

FUNDING SUPPORT FOR BIA EASTERN REGION OFFICE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes leadership; and
- WHEREAS, Eastern Tribal Law Enforcement require additional services from the BIA, Eastern Region Office of Law Enforcement Services, Criminal Investigations sections; and
- WHEREAS, the funding for additional staff at the BIA Eastern Region office has not been appropriated; therefore be it
- **RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors request that the U.S. Department of Interior, BIA Office of Law Enforcement Services provide the necessary funds to establish additional criminal investigators positions for the Eastern Region to assist with Law Enforcement services for Eastern Region Tribes.
