USET Resolution No. 2001:18

HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) CONSULTATION POLICY

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Board of Directors passed resolution USET No. 2000:20 entitled, "Recommendations for a HUD Tribal Consultation Process" and HUD has failed to respond to the intent of the resolution; and
- WHEREAS, President Clinton issued Executive Order 13084 which directed all federal agencies to conduct meaningful consultation with tribal governments regarding policy decisions that impact tribal communities; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors reaffirms its support for development of the HUD consultation policy through the negotiated rule-making process; be it further
- **RESOLVED** the USET Board of Directors encourages all federally recognized tribes to instruct HUD to commit to this process.
