ENDORSEMENT OF THE NASHVILLE AREA OFFICE OF THE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE FISCAL YEAR 2003 CORE BUDGET FORMULATION TEAM

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprising twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the budget appropriation for the Indian Health Service (IHS) supports tribal programs, services, functions, and activities;
- WHEREAS, the Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) calls for the IHS to consult with tribes (IHS customers) in the formulation of the budget; and
- WHEREAS, in compliance with GPRA requirements the IHS has been directed to form a Core Budget Formulation Team consisting of Tribal Representatives to advocate on behalf of USET member tribes in development of the yearly IHS budget submission; therefore, be it

 Township; Meg Parsons, Oneida Indian Nation of New York; Arlene Mack,

 Fuller of USET as members of the Nashville Area Office (NAO) of the Indian
 Health Service (IHS) FY2003 Core Budget Formulation Team.
