USET Resolution No. 2001:054

CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN USET TRIBAL DIABETES PROJECT GRANT

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, a special appropriation was made in the 1997 Balanced Budget Act to fund Special Diabetes Programs for Indians (SDPI) grants; and
- WHEREAS, twenty-two (22) of the member tribes, excluding the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians and the Cayuga Nation, have chosen to have USET apply for the SDPI grant on their behalf; and
- WHEREAS, Congress appropriated additional funding for the SDPI grants beginning in fiscal year 2001; and
- WHEREAS, the additional funding will be made available to current SDPI grantees as supplemental awards; now, therefore be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors affirms their continued support of the USET Tribal Diabetes Project with regard to the supplemental funding award.
