USET Resolution No. 2001:074

Proposed Training of Tribal Leaders and Housing Directors to Increase Understanding of NAHASDA

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, NAHASDA provides necessary resources to provide adequate and safe housing for American Indians/Alaska Natives (AI/AN) communities, and
- WHEREAS, the current authorization for NAHASDA is scheduled to expire in the year 2002; and
- WHEREAS, training for Tribal Leaders and Housing Directors would increase the knowledge and understanding of NAHASDA; and
- WHEREAS, the National American Indian Housing Council (NAIHC) is agreeable to providing such training; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors supports a scheduled NAHASDA training session, and that the training be provided in conjunction with the NAIHC, and that both Tribal Leaders and tribal Housing Directors from all USET Tribes be strongly encouraged to attend.
