USET Resolution No. 2001:075

Continued Funding of the Drug Elimination Program

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and,
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the board of Directors comprises delegated from the member tribes' leadership; and,
- WHEREAS, drugs problems exist on and near tribal territories; and
- WHEREAS, the USET tribes depend on Drug Elimination Program funds for keeping tribal communities drug free; and
- WHEREAS, the USET tribes have seen improvements in drug awareness and drug elimination through these type of programs; and
- WHEREAS, absence of Drug Elimination Program funds would make the tribes unable to continue to eliminate such drug problems; and
- WHEREAS, these funds are scheduled for elimination under the Bush Administration proposed 2002 Budget, and such action would negatively impact many needed Tribal Programs; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors supports the continued funding for Drug Elimination Programs in the Federal Budget.
