USET Resolution No. 2001:076

Continued Funding of the Rural Development Block Grant

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and,
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegated from the member tribes' leadership; and,
- WHEREAS, the USET tribes depend upon Rural Development Block Grant funds for infrastructure development and to provide safe, sanitary housing for Tribal Members; and,
- WHEREAS, the USET tribes utilize these funds to develop micro-enterprises, entrepeneurships, and economic development; and,
- WHEREAS, these funds are scheduled for elimination under the Bush Administration proposed 2002 Budget, and such action would negatively impact many needed tribal programs; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors supports the continued funding of the Rural Development Block Grant Program in the Federal Budget.
