## USET Resolution No. 2001:078

## ELIMINATION OF LOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT AND DAVIS-BACON REQUIREMENTS

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET), is an inter-tribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribe's leadership; and
- WHEREAS, NAHASDA provides necessary resources to provide adequate and safe housing for American Indian/Alaskan Native (AI/AN) communities; and
- WHEREAS, the current authorization for NAHASDA is scheduled to expire in the year 2002; and
- WHEREAS, the Local Cooperative Agreement (LCA) and Davis-Bacon Act are placing tremendous hardships on tribes in implementing and providing safe and sanitary housing to tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the LCA infringes upon and violates tribal sovereignty; and
- WHEREAS, the provisions of the technical amendments do not go far enough to alleviate the burden caused by the LCA and Davis-Bacon; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors takes a formal position for the total removal of the LCA Requirement and the Davis-Bacon Wage Requirement as NAHASDA comes before the U.S. Congress for Reauthorization.
