FEDERAL COMMUNICATION COMMISSION APPOINTMENT

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, there is currently a vacant seat on the Federal Communication Commission; and
- WHEREAS, it is vital to the interests of the USET members of USET that the Commission should understand and be sensitive to issues that have impact upon the tribes; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Joe García exhibits such a sensitivity and understanding of Tribal concerns, together with the requisite experience and background to fulfill the responsibilities of Commissioner; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors urges the United States Senate to look with favor upon the appointment and confirmation of Mr. García to the Federal Communication Commission.
