## **ADDITIONAL TRIBAL POLICE**

Whereas, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal agranization associated for the state of th

intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally

recognized tribes; and

Whereas, the actions taken by USET Board of Directors officially represents

the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and

Whereas, due to the events of September 11, 2001, and the need for greater

protection from similar events and crises in the future, the USET Tribal Justice Committee recommends that more resources are needed for security in tribal territories; therefore, be it resolved

Resolved that the USET Board of Directors requests that the Bureau of

Indian Affairs (BIA) work with USET tribes to identify and secure needed resources to address the security concerns of the tribes.
