RESOLUTION FOR USET BOARD TO ENDORSE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE BY-LAWS

- WHEREAS, the United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an inter-tribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represents the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, transportation issues impact virtually every aspect of a community, such as economic development, education, health care, travel, tourism, planning, land use, and employment opportunities; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Board has established a Transportation Committee for the purpose of reviewing issues of concern and policy regarding transportation programs for and/or affecting USET tribes, and to provide the Board with proposed recommendations and resolutions for consideration; and
- WHEREAS, the Transportation Committee has adopted the attached By-Laws for consideration by the USET Board of Directors; and
- **WHEREAS,** the By-Laws are to be used to conduct official business by the Transportation Committee; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors endorses the Transportation Committee By-Laws as attached.
